- Mrs. Stanley for organizing a STEM event for girls this week! Y chromosomes NOT allowed!



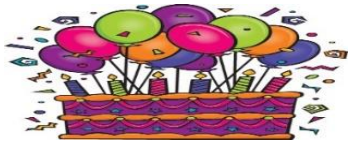
