  - Attendance (absences and tardies)

- Preliminary selections interviewed with writing sample
- Selections finalized and confirmed by committee
- CFI student body demographics resemble district's grade level demographics

#### **CLASSROOM INSTRUCTION**

- Mrs. Arick: Math and Social Studies; Mrs. Ridley: RLA and Science
- Most days, time is split evenly between the two teachers.
