

Abilene Independent School District Supplemental Music Lesson Program Scholarship Requirements

Abilene ISD secondary music programs are committed to providing scholarship opportunities for students enrolled in the Abilene ISD Supplemental Music Lesson Program. These scholarships are designed to encourage students who might not otherwise have the opportunity to study music privately. Scholarships are intended for students who have indicated a sincere desire to become better musicians and contribute their talents to the strengthening of their own musical organization. Private study is a very important means to becoming musically proficient.

Students must meet the requirements listed below in order to qualify for these scholarships.

- Students must be enrolled in the secondary music program.
- Students must submit a completed *Scholarship Application* form to their campus director.
- Scholarships awarded may be used for study only in the Abilene ISD Supplemental Music Lesson Program.
- Students must remain academically eligible in order to retain the scholarship privilege.
- Scholarships will be awarded based on merit and need.
- Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the instructor.
- Scholarship funds will not be paid for unexcused absences from lessons.

Scholarship Award Letters will be mailed prior to the student's first lesson of the school year. Scholarship awards will terminate at the conclusion of each school year.
