

## DWCC Minutes – Monday, October 22, 2012

## **District-Wide Consultation Committee**

The DWCC met Monday, October 22, 2012, at 4:10 pm in the Valley View Room at One AISD Center. Chair, Cindy Earles, called the meeting to order. Members present were, Sharlyn Bammel, Cindy Boyd, Al Dunlap, Cindy Hay, Adam Turner and Tom Tomaras. Also present was Karen Stover.

## > AISD 2013-2014 School Calendar Discussion:

- The 2013-2014 School Calendar was not voted on at the October 9, 2012, meeting; therefore, the
  members recapped the options for school holidays, teacher workdays, inclement weather days and
  alternative staff development days.
- Once the calendar review was completed, the members decided that one change needed to be made by moving the May 10, 2014 inclement weather day to May 26, 2014, making Memorial Day a holiday/inclement weather day.
- The chair then asked for a vote to be made on the proposed 2013-2014 School Calendar. All present voted 'yes' except for a dissenting vote from Col. Al Dunlap.

## > AISD 2014-2015 School Calendar Discussion:

- The 2014-2015 School Calendar is very similar to the 2013-2014 School Calendar. The start date, August 25, is set by the state, and graduation date, May 30 is set by district administration.
- Once again, members were mindful to ensure the proposed calendar had 177 school days for students plus an additional 10 days for teachers.
- Proposed 2014-15 testing dates are not available from TEA at this time and will have to be added to the calendar at a later date.
- The members discussed options available for holidays, IW days, workdays and ASD and then
  voted on the proposed 2014-2015 School Calendar. The vote was unanimous to accept the
  calendar as proposed.
- > Karen Stover will talk with the Superintendent regarding posting the 2013-14 and 2014-15 calendars on the AISD website for staff/community review.
