When naming an assessment, please follow the following naming scheme:

Campus number_Grade_Subject abbreviation_Test type_Scope code_Month abbreviation_Year

- > This title is short enough to show on reports and on the preview panel while giving enough information to tell what the benchmark is.
- ➤ Keeping the same naming scheme across the district will assist in support and transfer of knowledge as position and responsibilities change.
- Notice the campus number is first to allow for quicker access within Aware's retrieval method.

Scope Code:

D – District level

(all students in the district at a particular grade level and subject will be taking this benchmark)

C – Campus level

(all students in a particular grade level and subject at a campus will be taking this benchmark)

T – Teacher level

(all students in a teacher's class at a particular campus, grade level, and subject will be taking this benchmark)

Test Type (or short description):

CL – Classroom Test (Xsw - # six weeks test – example 3sw = Third six weeks)

BM – Benchmark

TT – Target Test

Com – Common Assessment

SemEx – Semester Exam

F&P – Fountas and Pinnell Assessment
