

Dear Principals,

We are excited to continue our Arts Outreach program for the 2021-2022 school year with accommodations for safety. We look forward to serving 3rd, 4th and 5th graders at your campus. Please be sure to email me the names of teachers that will act as my contact person in each of your schools or have them contact me. I need a contact for each grade level and an email addresses if at all possible.

In 3rd and 4th grades we visit each classroom 4 times per year, 2 in the fall and 2 in the spring. We will need at least an hour but would love 75 minutes if at all possible. Remember, this is only 4 times a year so we want to make it GREAT. During our visits each student will create a unique piece of art while learning the elements and principles of art, art appreciation, about famous artists, critical thinking, creative expression, self-confidence, and more.

For the 5th graders, the program is a little more comprehensive in that we will visit each classroom 7 times per year and extend beyond what has been taught in the earlier grades. The time requirement and our goals are the same as above but we will be there a little more often. This way we are getting the students ready for middle school art classes.

This program is funded by Abilene ISD and the Abilene Education Foundation and is a partnership that helps the teachers be able to meet the visual arts requirements in their classrooms. Plus it gives your students a chance for creative expression. Many of you have art aids in your schools, but we plan to continue to serve your students. We love coming to your schools. We work very hard to create a meaningful and valuable program. We have been working with AISD this summer to insure that students will be safe and we are very excited about providing more materials for the students in this school year.

AISD has also arranged for all schools to have **free field trips** to the museum-Please take advantage of this wonderful opportunity.
