

Youth Art Month 2022

Important Information for Teachers-please read all!

- Artwork and an inventory list of students and title of work will be accepted between 10am and 5pm Tuesday, February 8, through Saturday, February 12, 2022. Late deliveries beyond this date will be accepted if you have made arrangements to hang your own work. Please do not send artwork with students.
- Ask for Kathryn Mitchell or Annemarie Holder when delivering artwork (unless it is Saturday). You will receive reception invitations and family passes for students in the show. If they are not available, there will be extras in the 3rd floor classroom. Please fill-in your information on the YAM participant sheet as well.
- Encourage students and their families to attend the reception on Thursday, February 17, 2022, from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Refreshments will be provided. All teachers are encouraged to attend to meet with students and families. The 2020 reception had over 2,000 people. We also digitized the exhibition and plan to do it again.
- All artwork must arrive matted in white or black (except 3-D works, works on canvas, or canvas panels). We make acceptations upon request. Feel free to contact Kathryn Mitchell about matting. Please make sure each piece is labeled with student name and school on the back. This is because often the labels fall off.
- SIZE CHANGE –It is recommended that artwork size should be no larger than 18” X 12” INCLUDING MAT! – If your size exceeds 18 x 12 then you must reduce the number of pieces you bring to exhibit.
- Please label the work with a white label located in the **lower right hand corner** (this can hang from the work) in the following format:

Student Name
Title of Work
Medium
School (space) Art Teacher
Grade or Level

*(Please use Arial 14 point. Use the ART teacher’s name not the classroom teacher)

This label is a **requirement**. We want the parents to easily find work. Whatever container or portfolio left with the art needs the **teacher’s name and school** plainly visible so that we can return it with the correct art at the end of the exhibit.

Space allotted for this exhibit is on the second floor in Galleries A, B, and C.

- Please do not bring any artwork with glitter.
- Artwork displaying violence will not be hung.
- **Please be conscientious about fragile pieces, we can't be responsible for the damage that may occur.**
- Please schedule to pick up the art between March 21-25, 2022. It will be located on the 3rd floor in the education center. **Any art left past this time may be discarded. Please call if you forgot. We want you to have your work back.**
- Please note the list below with the number of pieces allotted per school.

High and Middle School will be allowed up to 25 pieces per art teacher.

High and Middle Schools with one art teacher are allowed up to 35 total pieces.

BCHE and private schools will be allowed up to 35 pieces total.

Elementary Schools are allowed 8 pieces per grade level.

- I would like to encourage you to bring only one piece per student. Not a rule, just a suggestion. You are allowed to mount more than one work on a matt.

Thank you so much for your hard work in this collaboration. It is a wonderful thing you do for your students. All of the area art teachers do an amazing job. I truly look forward to this exhibit every year! Let me know if you have any questions at all.
