






## **EKG** Technician

# **EKG Technician Responsibilities:**

- Performing cardiovascular tests on patients.
- Keeping patients informed on every step of the procedure.
- Identifying and diagnosing heart conditions.
- Monitoring patient blood pressure.
- Collecting cardiovascular data for analysis by doctors.
- Working alongside doctors and nurses.
- Setting up EKG components including EKG tracings for accurate readings.
- Ensuring the safety and comfort of patients.
- Maintaining high hospital safety standards.
- Monitoring EKG equipment and reporting any malfunctions.



## Medical Assistant

#### Administrative Duties

- Using computer applications
- Answering telephones
- Welcoming patients
- Updating and filing patient medical records
- Coding and filling out insurance forms
- Scheduling appointments
- Arranging for hospital admissions and laboratory services
- Handling correspondence, billing, and bookkeeping





## Medical Assistant Cont.

#### Clinical Duties

- Taking medical histories
- Explaining treatment procedures to patients
- Preparing patients for examination
- Assisting the physician during exams
- Collecting and preparing laboratory specimens
- Performing basic laboratory tests
- Instructing patients about medication and special diets
- Preparing and administering medications as directed by a physician
- Transmitting prescription refills as directed
- Drawing blood
- Taking electrocardiograms

## **Transportation to Clinical**

- When clinical begins in late February, students will need their own transportation to and from their clinical site.

## Uniform Requirements

- 1st set scrubs free students should already have a set
  - top, pant, jacket
- + 1 more set, highly recommended, Will be using a new vendor this year
- White tennis shoes/clinical shoes
  - no canvas or mesh



#### **Clinical Dress**

- What to wear/acceptable appearance:
  - Purple scrubs with patch on left arm
  - Proper PPE
    - Surgical mask covering nose and mouth
  - White shoes/socks
  - Name badge/no phone (keep in your bag)
  - Watch with second hand
  - Hair out of face, off the collar
  - Minimal make-up
  - Earring studs (no gems)/no extra jewelry or facial piercings
  - Nails short, clean, nothing on them
  - Report by assigned time, ready to take work



#### **State Exam**

- Your written State test will cost \$117.00. Your fee (\$31.50) will be due the end of November for EKG Exam.
- CCMA Exam will cost \$155.00. Your fee (\$31.50) will be due in April.
