Responsibilities for Pharmacy Technician

- Read and interpret physician medication orders
- Prepare and package chemotherapy medications and other medications requiring special handling in accordance with safety measures
- Aid in filling, processing, and dispensing medications
- Re-package and label medications
- Adhere to safety practices in order to ensure quality care for patients
- Help maintain the drug inventory through inventory control practices
- Provide customer service by answering phone calls in a prompt and courteous manner
- Check for expiration dates on medications on a regular basis

Clinical Dress

- What to wear/acceptable appearance:
 - Purple scrubs with patch on left arm
 - Proper PPE
 - Surgical mask covering nose and mouth
 - White shoes/socks
 - Name badge/no phone (keep in your bag)
 - Watch with second hand
 - Hair out of face, off the collar
 - Minimal make-up
 - Earring studs (no gems)/no extra jewelry or facial piercings
 - Nails short, clean, nothing on them
- Report by assigned time, ready to take work
