Good Evening Mann Parents and Guardians:

This week is the middle of the 2nd Six Weeks. Students must complete work for progress reports by this Friday and Progress Reports will be mailed to parents for any student whose grade is 74 or lower a week from tomorrow. Please talk to your child about the value of coordinating with teachers for tutorials and make up work as soon as they need help. We do have a tutorial bus for any student who normally rides the bus each Tuesday and Thursday which leaves campus at 4:20 p.m.

As we get farther into winter, the skies are staying darker longer in the mornings.
