Good Evening Mann Parents and Guardians:

I have 3 announcements for you:

#1: On Thursday and Friday students may wear high school appropriate clothing with Christmas attire (Santa hats, reindeer ears, ugly Christmas sweaters etc.) This is a great time to reinforce high school dress code so here is a recap of significant items (the total list is on AISD's web page).

Items kids really like to wear that are permissible are: shredded jeans (no skin showing above finger tips), slide shoes (no houseshoes), logos on t-shirts appropriate for school.

Items still not permissible per Student Code of Conduct: hoodies with the hood worn over the head, piercings other than small studs or clear spacers, bandannas, tank tops, muscle shirts, spaghetti straps, exposed midriff or backs, shorts or skirts shorter than finger tips fully extended, leggings or tights by themselves (they must have shorts or skirts or appropriate coverage below the finger tips other than the leggings or tights), hair that covers the eyes. If a student has a question, please have them ask before they have no other options. Usually they do a great job!

#2: Please make arrangements for early dismissal on Friday, December 15 at 1:30 pm. We will have assemblies for fine arts presentations and to honor the hard work of all students, we will not interrupt the presentations to get students from the auditorium until the presentations are complete for that grade level. 6th grade assemblies are 1st period, 7th grade assemblies are 3rd period and 8th grade assemblies are 4th period. Thanks for your help with this.

#3: Final exams for high school credit courses are still being completed and the 3rd Six Weeks grades and Semester averages will be finalized on Friday before teachers leave for the break. Thanks for encouraging your child to take care of any missing work or redo assignments as soon as they know they need to.
