





## Aware Online Testing Experience for Students

<p>Students access the online testing page from the student homepage by selecting Aware Online testing.</p>	
<p>1. Log into the site with their student ID and password of aisdstudent.</p>	
<p>2. Students choose the available online test.</p>	
<p>3. Students navigate between questions. 4. Students <b>Save</b> and <b>Score</b> the test.</p>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Save Test</b> means the student can access the test again at a later time, as long as the online test is still in Active mode and Started by the test administrator.</li> <li>• <b>Score Test</b> means the answers are being submitted for scoring, and the test can no longer be accessed. Answers will be locked in.</li> </ul>	

## Aware Online Testing Experience for Students

Icons in the lower left corner  
The first orange square at the left is the online ruler.  
The second orange square at the left is the highlighting text tool.



If a resource or reading passage exists for a question, then students can toggle between the question and the resource.



Before submitting a test for scoring, students should check to make sure they have answered all of the questions.

If they have not, then the following message will appear, and students have 3 options:

1. **Save Test** and return to complete the online test at a later time.
2. **Submit Test Without Filling In Answers** which will count all unanswered questions as being wrong with no answer.
3. Click on the individual questions to answer the blank ones before submitting the test for scoring.
