Minutes for Wednesday, December 6, 2017

The District-Wide Consultation Committee (DWCC) met on Wednesday December 6, 2017 at 4:30 p.m., in the Board Room at One AISD Center. Mr. Thomas welcomed the DWCC and the Communication Committees.

Dr. Young had four examples of the 2018-2019 calendar. He also passed out the results and feedback from the survey. He would like the committees to narrow down to one District of Innovation and one Non-District of Innovation calendar to present to the Board.

Monday night at the Board meeting, they discussed forming a DOI Committee; there will be a public hearing to discuss District of Innovation. The committee will consist of 35 individuals.
