Minutes for Wednesday, February 1, 2017

The District-Wide Consultation Committee (DWCC) met on Wednesday, February 1, 2017, at 4:30 p.m., in the Jefferson Room at One AISD Center. Dr. Young called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. and welcomed the DWCC Committee and the Communication Committees.

Dr. Young discussed the Survey that was sent out to the employees through Eduphoria. 1,008 voted for Option 1 Calendar and 539 voted for Option 2 Calendar. The committee has discussed needing to have a workday before coming back from Christmas Break., but they did not want to have January 5, 2018 as a workday. Both Committees has agreed to leave December 22, 2017 as an Alternative Staff Development Day and change January 5, 2018 to an Alternative Staff Development Day. Carey Kitts made a motion to accept the 2017-2018 Option 1 school calendar with the changes. Linda White second the motion. The motion carried unanimously. The calendar will be presented to the Board on February 13, 2017 during the next Board meeting.

Dr. Barton discussed the District Wide Community Involvement. The committee needs to decide if we want to add criteria to the Fine Arts Department for the elementary schools. Each school will get to choose five. The schools do not have to choose the same thing. After discussion, the committee has decided to add a generic category. For example: Local Fine Arts such as Art walk, The Nickel, field trips. Elizabeth Wagstaff made a motion to add an "Other" category to the list. Carey Kitts second the motion. The motion carried unanimously.

Roger Thomas reminded the committee that there are two positions open on the DWCC Committee, to think of who would be good to serve on the committee.
