Meal Prices and Charge Policy

Breakfast Pricing

****For a reimbursable breakfast at all grade levels, a student must select at least three of the four items offered. One of the three must be a fruit or fruit juice. If a student chooses not to take the minimum number of items (3) they will be charged a-la-carte prices. Under offer vs serve students must be allowed to make their own choices****

Prices for Breakfast are:

- Full Price : \$2.00
- Reduced Price: \$0.30
- Breakfast in Classroom: No Charge

Lunch Pricing

****For a reimbursable lunch at all grade levels, a student must select at least three of the five components offered. One of the three must be a fruit or vegetable. If a student chooses not to take the minimum number of components (3) they will be charged a-la-carte prices. Under offer vs serve students must be allowed to make their own choices****

Prices for Head Start and Elementary Lunch are:

- Full Price: \$2.75
- Reduced Price: \$0.40

Prices for Secondary Lunch are:

- Full Price: \$3.00
- Reduced Price: \$0.40

Adult Meal Prices:

- Breakfast: \$2.50
- Lunch: \$3.75

Meal Charge Policy

Elementary students will be allowed to charge up to \$6.00. Middle School and High School students up to \$3.00. Once this amount is reached the student will be offered an Entrée Exchange Meal consisting of a Cheese Sandwich, Fruit, Vegetable and Milk. The students account will be debited at a reduced amount. Payments to satisfy a negative account balance and bring the account up to date may be made at the campus cafeteria or at myschoolbucks.com. Charging will be discontinued three weeks prior to the last day of school. There are no charges allowed for Adults.
