FAQ's about the Bison Band

1. How much money does it cost to be in the band?

The biggest expense will, of course, be the instrument. Instead of purchasing an instrument, we suggest the rental/purchase plan from our local music store.

Woodwind players (clarinets, saxophones, oboes) will have the added expense of reeds.

Another small expense will be our beginner book.

Please do not let any financial issues keep you from being in band. Please contact us to see how we can be of assistance.

2. Does the school district provide any instruments?

Yes, the school district will provide the more expensive instruments. Tuba, French Horn, Euphonium, Oboe and Bassoon.

3. How do we know what instrument to choose?

We strongly encourage you to attend one of our instrument selection this summer. There will be directors here to help each student make this important decision. This will be a joint decision between the director, parents, and most importantly, the student. We cannot guarantee anything before you try an instrument, but we will do what we can to pair you with the instrument you want to play. There will be a limited number of students to play percussion and saxophone.

4. Are there certain brands of instruments we must use?

Yes, Mrs. McGrew and Mrs. Reece will provide you a list of AISD recommended instrument brands at our instrument selection nights. The brand of instrument you rent/purchase is very important. Please adhere to the list we recommend!

5. Can we be in both band and athletics throughout middle school?

Absolutely! Our administration, coaches and directors make every effort to avoid conflicts in scheduling so that students may participate in both programs. The majority of band students are actively involved in athletics.
