Please apply the following guidelines for extracurricular/co-curricular activities occurring before and during national and state assessments for the 2021-2022 school year:

No district field trips or extracurricular/co-curricular activities that result in student absences from class should occur during the **dates listed below for each testing event** except for Scheduled UIL events/Curriculum Contests.

Additionally, no school activities should be scheduled the evenings before testing.
